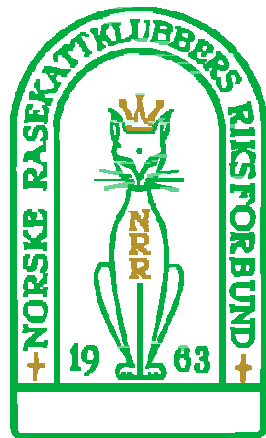

5. General conditions set by NRR

Kittens shall not be delivered to a new home until they are at least 10 weeks old. It is recommended to wait until the kitten is 12 weeks old in order to be certain that the cat has developed its immune defense and has established fundamental socialization.

All cats that are sold shall have vaccination documents and a health certificate from a veterinarian. Cats from registered breeds shall also have a pedigree from NRR, or documents showing that a pedigree has been requested from NRR. The seller shall send a declaration of transfer of ownership, so that the new owner can be entered into the NRR registry. Seller can do this by copying page 2 of this contract, sign it at the upper right and send the signed copy to NRR.

Cats can be registered either in the main registry (LO) or the control registry (RIEX). Class 1-registration is used for cats with no restrictions on breeding. Cats that the breeder wishes to withhold from breeding can be registered in class 2. The breeder can have the cat transferred to class 1 later. NRR can register cats in class 3. Such cats are prohibited from breeding except by express permission from NRR. Most cats entered in the control registry (RIEX) must be approved for breeding according to NRR rules before any progeny from them may be registered.

Buyer confirms that the cat has been examined at the time of transfer and found in order. Seller confirms that buyer has been informed about any faults in the cat that he/she knows about; about genetic faults in the breed and the cat's possible genes for these faults. Seller confirms that the buyer has been informed about feeding, care and treatment of the cat. If a cat that has faults is sold, of next page, the seller has a duty to inform the buyer about this. The cat is then transferred on special conditions to be written down below in section 6.
